### **The Position & Responsibilities**

Squamish Terminals has an immediate opening for a Maintenance Superintendent. This permanent position plays an important leadership role in the maintenance operations of the Terminal. Take advantage of this exciting opportunity to be part of a great team focused on building a culture of safety and operational excellence.

Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, Lynnterm & Squamish Terminals, this position's primary responsibility is to coordinate and oversee maintenance and project activities required to support our 24 hour per day, 7 day per week operation at Squamish Terminals.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following duties, with safety being the number one priority:

- Oversee supervision of maintenance and project activities to ensure budget and schedule are met and infrastructure is working as per design, including but not limited to:
  - Mobile equipment fleet
  - Berths, warehouses, yards, and rail track siding
  - Administration, maintenance, operations, and security buildings
  - Maintenance shop equipment
  - Utilities systems (e.g., electrical, fire protection, plumbing, HVAC)
- Develop, plan, and maintain scheduled and unscheduled preventative maintenance programs including key performance indicators (KPI) for measuring system/equipment reliability and long-range performance.
- Consult and collaborate with operations team to identify objectives, priorities, and changing needs. Coordinate labor, equipment, and supplies to ensure continuous workflow and remain on schedule.
- Participate in the implementation and on-going maintenance of a new computerized maintenance management system for tracking work orders, preventative maintenance schedules, parts inventory, and maintenance history of equipment and site infrastructure.
- Develop contractor work specifications and request for proposals. Review contractor proposals and provide recommendations to management. Supervise and inspect contractor work performed to determine compliance to work specification.
- Read and interpret technical drawings and sketches as required.



- Serve as maintenance advisor on projects and operations, assisting contractors and management teams with project progress/deviations, difficult maintenance and project related problems.
- Supervision and mentorship of maintenance personnel while providing daily direction on planned work assignments.
- Monitor the use and inventories of parts, maintenance supplies and equipment.
- Develop standard operating procedures (SOP's) and ensure that all work is carried out in a safe manner in compliance with health, safety and environmental policies, procedures, and applicable provincial and federal regulations.
- Participate in safety & quality programs and audits; incident investigations; daily/weekly toolbox and project meetings.

### **Qualifications & Requirements**

The successful candidate brings a natural, people focused proactive leadership style and understands the importance of maintaining a strong team. Embedding worker safety and performance improvements into Company culture is at the heart of everything you do.

The ideal candidate will possess:

- A Degree or Red Seal in Mechanical/Electrical engineering or trade qualifications.
- A minimum of 5 years' managerial or supervisory experience encompassing logistics and distribution in a heavy industry environment; marine preferred.
- Strong leadership and relationship skills managing in a unionized environment and the ability to handle competing priorities while working under pressure.
- Knowledge of preventative maintenance programs, materials handling equipment is essential for success in this role.
- A thorough understanding of Collective Agreements and relevant safety standards are also essential.
- Sound knowledge of cost control and budgeting.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, computer proficiency and the ability to impart knowledge and foster a culture of inclusion.
